The second day of the 5th World Nomad Games brought to Kazakhstan 14 gold, 3 silver and 8 bronze medals

The second day of the V World Nomad Games competition happened in different locations of Astana, Kazakhstan.

Kokpar competitions were held at the Kazanat equestrian tourist club with the participation of 104 athletes from 9 countries. The teams from Kazakhstan, USA, Russia, Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan, Hungary, China, Mongolia and Turkey competed in the qualifying round. Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Russia and Turkey were the strongest and went into the next round.

Also, in the ethno-aul, located next to the Kazanat, Audaryspak (horseback wrestling) competitions were held with the participation of 64 athletes from the same countries. Yermek Kuralbay, Almat Lyatipbek, Daryn Otkelbay won gold medals for Kazakhstan.

Traditional archery competitions started at the Argymak equestrian sports complex. 183 athletes from 33 countries were taking part in the game, including 10 representatives of the Kazakhstan national team. Zhibek Kulmyrzayev won the gold medal, Kanat Kassymkhan, Aikorkem Batikhan received a bronze medal

Qazaq Kuresi competitions were held at the Martial Arts Palace named after Zh. Ushkempirov. Here, 274 athletes from 41 countries were fighting for victory, competing in 8 weight categories among men and women. Aizhan Zhylkybayeva, Bekzhan Tolepov, Nazerke Azamatova, Meiirzhan Bereketov, Rauza Nurmukhametova, Didar Tukyshev and Bakhyt Kussakbayeva, Zhumazhan Kozhabekov took a gold medal.

Kurash tournament was held at the Alau Ice Palace, in which 106 athletes from 27 countries will take part. Albina Bakhiyeva won a gold medal, Marat Baykamurov, Azhar Salykova won silver medals, Yerzat Argynov, Bekadil Shaimerdenov and Ulbolsyn Adilova took a bronze medal.

As part of the V World Nomad Games, competitions in Mas-wrestling, the national sport of the Sakha people, went in Kazakhstan. 98 athletes from 31 countries were taking part in this competition. Takhmina Kozhamberdiyeva, Assylmurat Birimzhan took the bronze medals.

Zhamby Atu Korean Style (horseback archery) – the winners are in 3 categories: Batyr Beksauyt won the gold medal, Aitbek Sarybay got a silver, and Yeralkhan Aikoz took a bronze medal.
